The Southern Fulton girls' elementary basketball had another successful season. The elementary recreation season consisted of 43 girls in grades 4-6. The girls were split into 6 teams and each team played 8 games. Many members of the high school and Jr. high teams volunteered their time to help with the program: Kayla Wertz, Kayla Chilcote, Taelor Morton, Macey Hollenshead, Ashley Roman, Maddie Mellott, Tylar Smith, Olivia Mottern, Lakyn Morton, and Drew Hann.

The travel team consisted of 33 girls and three teams, (13- 6th grade, 10- 5th grade, and 10 – 4th grade) The traveling team was part of the Sidling Hill league, consisting of SF, McConnellsburg, Forbes Road, Southern Huntingdon, and Tussey Mountain. Our 6th grade girls finished the league with a record of 7-1, 5th grade finished 5-3, and our 4th grade finished 5-1-2. We also played Chestnut Ridge on one of our off weekends.

The tournament team consisted of 8 – 6th grade, 3 - 5th grade, and 1-4th grade girl. The team won the Sidling Hill Tournament with wins over Tussey Mountain and Southern

Huntingdon. We finished our season at the Everett Tournament finishing with a record of 2-1. We lost our first game to Spring Cove (6th grade), but finished with wins over Everett and Spring Cove (5th grade team). Our 6th grade team finished the year with a record of **12 wins and 2 losses**.

We ended the year with a pizza party for all the kids that participated in the elementary program. I would like to give special thanks to Linda Bolden and Tammy Hixon for running our concession stand and organizing the end of the year party. Also, Bill Shilling, Jeremy Hann, Tracy Covalt, and Macey Hollenshead for refereeing our home basketball games.
