*Superintendent Report*

**Natural Gas**

Natural gas is to the building waiting to turn a valve and it will be in the building. They were going to shut down the furnace that is running and start the natural gas. My response was that they need to repair the damaged boiler, get it hooked up and running before we shut down the one presently running and convert to natural gas. The boiler is to be repaired next week under direct supervision of the manufacturer to insure our warranty on the boiler will continue to be enforced. Once the boiler is repaired it will be hooked up to natural gas and brought on line to be made operational. Then the one presently running on LP gas will be converted over to natural gas.

**Stolen Check**

We had a check that was mailed to a company which was somehow stolen from that company and cashed after changing the name as to who the check was written too. Once all paperwork has been completed by the police we will receive our money back from the bank and the offended party will now become the bank who cashed the check with the name changed on the check.

**Auditorium Lights**

If we are able to find replacement electrical boards for the lighting system we will be looking at accepting a credit for the auditorium lighting. A big thank you goes to John Bain for being able to find replacement parts and presently has the majority of the lights working appropriately. If we accept a credit for the auditorium lights it will be a \$20,000 to \$30,000 savings. John has also ordered additional parts to have on hand for the lighting system to insure we will be able to continue to repair it if in the future parts are no longer available.
