### ***Superintendent Report***

##### **A. Metal Panels**

I have in the past submitted to you the four options we had at that time for metal panels. Once again I am attaching (Information Item #1) Lobar's communication regarding these four options. We have a fifth and final option which is for Tnemec Company to repaint the panels a solid color. A sample of the material was sent to them and has been blasted, primed, and painted white. At this time we do not have a price however we do know they can blast, prime, and paint the panels after they are up. The down side is the panels will only have a two year limited warranty whereas the panels as is from factory have a 30 year warranty. Option five in the process where as we do not have a price as of yet would be to mount the panels, strip the paint, primer, and then paint white. As soon as I get a price I will let you know immediately. A possible option 6, I would suggest you give consideration to is to mount the panels, see what we have once all panels are mounted and then make a decision as to whether or not you wish to spend the money to have them stripped, primed, and painted. A decision on this will definitely need to be made as soon as we can in order to insure the project can be completed in a timely fashion.

#### **Busing**

After having spent some time looking at bus routes and the number of students on the buses I am about 90% sure we will be able to reroute buses and eliminate the route Rodney Leese is giving up. However, should the PreK become a reality it will then be necessary to bid that as a separate route which is what many districts are already doing. Soon as school is out I will set a meeting with all bus contractors to discuss possibilities with regards to insuring all buses have relatively full loads and running the shortest routes in the best interest of the district.
