## *Superintendent Report*

### **Gym Floor**

On Friday, June 6, 2014, an evaluation of the gym floor with all parties involved will be at 10:00 a.m. I will keep you posted once I have detailed information concerning the estimated cost of damage and possible recommendation of repair.

### **Summer Placement**

To date we have not been able to find a senior interested in working during the summer. Presently, we have been able to work with the county to obtain one individual to work with the secretarial staff and one to work with the custodial staff for 24 hours each week with the county paying for the student's wages and benefits. This is being done at the county expense with money supplied by Southern Allegheny. Hopefully this will work out but if not we will then seek additional help later.
