Fall Sports Physicals

On Monday, June 1, the Southern Fulton School District held sports physicals for any student in grades 6-11 at the high school. June 1 is the first eligible day for physicals to be completed for the 2015-2016 school year. Interested 6th grade students, with parent permission, were transported to the high school by the Athletic Director so they could take advantage of this service. Any student that is going to participate in the 2015-2016 school year MUST have a sports physical, on the specific PIAA CIPPE form, dated June 1 or AFTER in order to be eligible.
