Youth Action Committee Meeting

As the principal representative on the youth action committee for Fulton County, I participated in the July meeting, which was held in the Southern Fulton Jr Sr High School library. This committee meets in order to address serious issues that have been identified via the PAYS (Pennsylvania Youth Support) report. Such issues include: Family Domain: Parental attitudes favorable towards anti-social behavior and School Domain: Opportunities for prosocial involvement. This committee is working on ways to increase parental involvement and is planning a positive messaging campaign that will involve school-aged students. I am working with the other two high school principals to begin this process.
