#### **Summer Biology Keystone Exams**

I am very excited to report that we received the results of the Summer Biology Keystone Exams and 7 out of the 9 students who participated in the remediation achieved Proficiency status. The 2 students that did not pass the exams did not attend every remediation session. The 7 students that did pass, came to the remediation and worked diligently to achieve Proficient scores. This is the first time we have ever tried this at Southern Fulton and it was a huge success!!! Not only I am very proud of these students and Mr. D for their hard work, but the students and parents are delighted as well. We are planning to offer this again next summer, as well as add Algebra I remediation.

#### **Professional Development/Reading Comprehension**

For the first time in 9 years, Southern Fulton High School offered in-house professional development for the staff at Southern Fulton. This professional development was co-lead by Mrs. Hendershot and Mr. Breslin. It was well attended and we look forward to monthly professional development opportunities.
