223. USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES	
1. Purpose	The Board regards the use of motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.
2. Authority	<p>The Board will permit the use of motor vehicles by students in accordance with the rules of the district provided that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students are licensed drivers. 2. Have parental/guardian permission. 3. Have been granted permission by the building principal to drive a motor vehicle on school grounds. 4. The owner of the vehicle provides documentation of proper liability coverage. <p>The Board will not be responsible for motor vehicles which are lost, stolen, or damaged.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent or designee shall develop rules and regulations for the operation and parking of motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to all students so affected.
4. Guidelines	<p>The use of student parking facilities provided by the school is a privilege. Students are expected to drive carefully and park properly.</p> <p>All cars driven to school must be registered in the high school office. There shall be no loitering in cars by students before, after, or during school hours.</p> <p>Maximum speed for operating any vehicle on the school property is 15 miles per hour whether posted or not.</p>

Failure to comply with all school district rules and laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including entering and leaving the parking lot in a safe manner, may result in the suspension of driving privileges and/or other disciplinary action which may include contacting the law enforcement officials.

Application Process

1. Students must complete the appropriate application.
2. Documentation of students' valid driver's license must be included on application.
3. Documentation of proper liability coverage must be included on the application.
4. Parental/Guardian consent is required for consideration of any application.
