COLLEGE ENROLLMENT OF STUDENTS</p> <p>The Board will permit students to leave high school prior to or during the senior year to attend approved colleges in accordance with the following guidelines and procedures and contingent upon the advance approval of the principal of the Southern Fulton Jr. - Sr. High School. The Southern Fulton School District diploma shall be awarded to students upon the successful completion of the requirement section of this policy.</p> <p><u>Early Admissions To A 4-Year University Or 2-Year Institution</u></p> <p>When a student is accepted as a full-time student in a 4-year or 2-year institution upon the completion of their Junior year of high school the district shall proceed as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The district shall honor the first year of college as completion of high school provided the student successfully completes the minimum number of credits each semester to maintain full-time status.</li> <li>2. The student will then be permitted to graduate with his/her class and be afforded all rights and privileges.</li> <li>3. All higher education costs are the responsibility of the student/parent(s).</li> <li>4. The student is not eligible to participate in extracurricular activities at the high school level.</li> </ol> <p><u>College Classes Offered On-Site</u></p> <p>When a student elects an approved college level course offered in our high school, the credits earned will be acceptable for high school graduation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The student's parent(s) will be expected to pay the tuition, book, and any lab fees.</li> </ol>
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2. The student is eligible to participate in all extracurricular activities at the high school.

College Credits Offered Off-Site

When a student maintains high school enrollment s/he must make the necessary arrangements to be able to take college courses at a campus during the school day. These credits will be applicable for high school graduation.

1. Tuition/Books/Fees will be the responsibility of the student/parent(s).
2. Transportation will be the responsibility of the student/parent(s).
3. The student is eligible to participate in all extracurricular activities at the high school level.

Part-Time Postsecondary Programs

For students choosing to attend a 2-year or 4-year college/trade school part-time while attending Southern Fulton High School, the following requirements have been developed.

The student must:

1. Have the prior approval of the principal and parent/guardian.
2. Meet all admissions requirements of the receiving institution and provide a letter of acceptance.
3. Complete or have scheduled sufficient credits in the high school to meet graduation requirements.
4. Submit college/trade school grades to the high school in a timely manner as established by the college/trade school grade-reporting schedule.

Additional considerations:

1. College/Trade school grades will not be included in class rank calculations.
2. Part-time college/trade school students will be considered for valedictorian honors. (College/Trade school grades not included in calculations.)
3. College/Trade school transcripts will be attached to the high school transcript.

4. Transportation and related costs are the responsibility of the student.
